The Primary PE and Sports Premium was launched by the Government in April 2013 and is available for three academic years: 2013/2014, 2014/2015 and 2015/2016

For this academic year (2013 – 2014) the school received **£8890** to help us to improve the quality and breadth of our PE and sport provision.
