You will be aware that after careful planning and preparation we have been able to start a phased reopening of school. In line with government guidance children in Nursery (N2 pupils due to start full time school in September), Reception, Year 1 and Year 6 are able to return to school. They will be working in small 'bubbles' of no more than 8 pupils in order to help keep them safe through social distancing.
