4. One of our focus books this term is "What the Ladybird Heard". Can you draw some lady birds with symmetrical dots? What is the total of their dots?

5. Float or Sink?
Gather some objects and predict if you think they will float or sink?
Test them in the bath/ kitchen sink/ paddling pool!

6. Its hard not seeing family or friends. Why not look at some photos and talk about them!
What are you going to do when you next see them!

7. Reading Den!
Create a den using blankets and cushions to create a cosy space to read your favourite books!

8. Shadow Puppet show!

Make different puppets of a wall using a torch! Can you make a show to put on your family! Try making a bird, a rabbit or even a crocodile!



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9. Hot/Cold Game

Something is hidden in the room. You're grown up helps you find it by saying "you're getting hot" if your close and "you're getting cold" if you're not.

10. Name Game!

How many objects in your house start with the same letter sound as your name?
See how many you can find!

11. Bubbles!

Make some bubbles with washing up liquid or bubble bath! How big can you make your bubbles!

12. Be a photographer.

Take 3 photos of your favourite things in your house. Why did you pick these things? Why not email them to me and let me know!

13. Make your name!

Can you use different objects in your house to make your name?

Buttons, shoe laces, lego, stones....

14. Make an instrument.

Use a recycled yoghurt pot/ jar/ box/ Fill it with something to make noises such as pasta/ rice to make a shaker!
