

Pre-School Home Learning Pack 2

This term our topic should have been **Growing!**
At school we were going to be looking at different seeds and try to grow our own cress. Why not try to grow your own plant or maybe a seed from your fruit or vegetables!

We would have been looking at animals that live on a farm. Our song to help us learn animal names and the sounds they make is 'Old McDonald had a farm'
Why not sing this and practice adding your own animals, don't forget to add the sounds.

Get those fine motor skills working!

Developing the muscles in the hand helps us to be able to write later on.
Games like threading- using anything with holes and some string.
Finger painting.
Try and use utensils to pick up different items around the house.

Insect Hunt!

Look around your garden if you have one. Or look out of the window. Can you see any insects?
Talk about what they look like, sound like, where might they be going?

Have fun with bubbles!

You can make some bubble solution using washing up liquid and water!
You then need something with a hole in it- get creative why not try to use a colander.
How many bubbles can you make?

We were going to be making our own sandwich at Pre-School and tasting some different vegetables.

Why not try and make your own at home- can you spread your own butter? Make sure you are using a safe butter knife to do this.
I would love to see your creations.

What's in the box game

Using a small box, gather some items from around the house. The adult holds the box and sings "what's in the box, what's in the box?, tap, tap, tap (whilst tapping on the box), what's in the box"
The child then puts their hand in whilst not peeping and tries to guess what it is. If they struggle to guess let them take it out. The child then sings "apple (change word here), in the box"
You can change this to photos and sing "Who's in the box?"

Full and Empty

Collect some different containers and practice filling and emptying them- explore different sizes.
The adult could add something with holes in the bottom or a sieve to make it harder to fill up.
