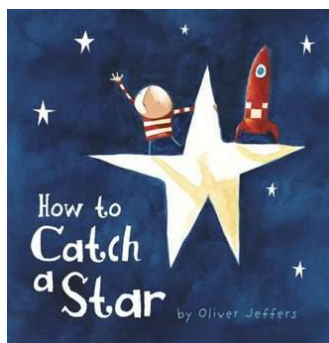


Summer 2 - Reception Home Learning Challenges

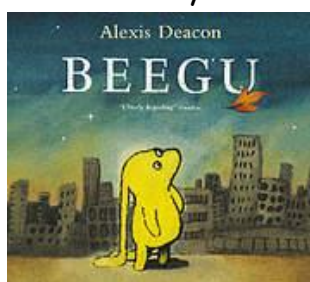
Hello everyone,

Activities linked to the books.

1. Listen to the story 'How to catch a Star' by Oliver Jeffers on youtube. <https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=rpyR6hJPxiw>
2. Listen to the song on youtube about the sun and the moon. <https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=Vb2ZXRh74WU>
3. Go outside and explore your own shadow. Watch Peeper Pig 'Shadows'. <https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=Iff38TWX384>
4. The boy tried to catch a star in all sorts of different ways, but none of them worked! Do you think that you could design a star-catching machine? You'll need to think about the different materials that you could use and label each part so that I know how it'll work. Draw and label your design and write a list of what you'll need.
5. Imagine that you had a star of your very own - what would you do with it? Write a list of fun things you would like to do.
6. Make a stargazing telescope from a kitchen roll tube and decorate it with sparkly stars.
7. Research the night sky and find out facts about the moon and stars.
8. The boy saw a reflection of a star in the water - what is a reflection and what different surfaces can we see reflections in?

10. If Beegu came to our playground what games would you play with Beegu?
