
Year Reception - Spring Term



- Get involved with doing jobs at home such as washing the pots, making breakfast, pairing up socks!

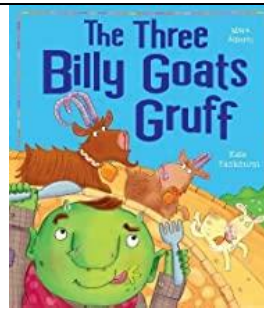
Our topic this Spring term is 'Once upon a time...' where we will be exploring different fairy tale stories.
