Thursday 7<sup>th</sup> March

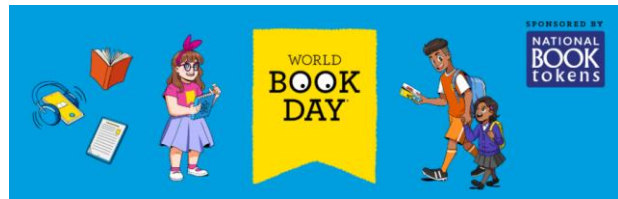
We will be celebrating World Book Day on Thursday 7<sup>th</sup> March 2024.

The theme was rainbow/mix it up. Pupils shared what they had been learning with some colour related activities around the room.





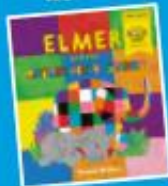
