Thirty-one Y5 pupils spent the final week of the Spring Term at Peat Rigg outdoor Training Centre near Pickering in North Yorkshire for a week of challenges, adventure and fun! Throughout the week they continued to demonstrate fantastic growth mindset, determination and resilience.

For many of these pupils it was their second residential experience, having attended Carlton Adventure near Stokesley when they were in Y4.
