What happens after a positive case?

If a staff member or pupil who has tested positive has been in school during their infectious period, all close contacts must self isolate for 14 days from their last contact with the case.

What is the infectious period?

The infectious period is from two days before the symptoms started (or the test date if there are no symptoms) until 10 days after symptoms started.

Bubbles and close contacts

After a positive test, the school risk assessment will identify which bubble the case has been in contact with and also any other staff or pupils who have been in close contact with the case during the infectious period.

What does close contact mean?

Close contact is defined as any of the following (without PPE):-

- Direct close contacts: Face to face contact for any length of time, within one metre, including being coughed on, face to face contact, or skin to skin contact
- Extended close contacts: Extended close contact (within 1 to 2 metres) for more than 15 minutes.
- Travel in a small vehicle like a car.

What action will the school take?

Anyone identified as having close contact with a confirmed case should self-isolate for 14 days following his or her last contact with the case.

The close contacts should only book a COVID-19 test if they develop symptoms. Family members of close contacts who are sent home do not need to self-isolate unless a contact develops symptoms.
