## Term Time Holidays

Please be aware that school is unable to  
authorise holidays in term time. Any holidays  
taken in term time are recorded as unauthorised  
absence and could result in parents being fined  
by Middlesbrough Council. Each parent/carer  
could be fined £60 for each child taken out of  
school – this rises to £120 if not paid within 21  
days.

For safeguarding reasons it is very important that  
we know where children are that should be in  
school. For this reason:-

## Safeguarding – Children not in School

- Parents and carers who take their children out  
of school for holidays in term time must  
complete a holiday request form before the  
holiday.
- Parents and carers of children who are too ill to  
attend school should contact the school by  
telephone. The school office is open from 8am  
each morning. ☎ (01642) 804 101
- Where possible medical appointments should  
be made outside of school time. Where this is  
unavoidable, proof of the medical appointment  
must be brought in to school when you collect  
your child. If the appointment is at the start of  
the school day then please telephone the school  
to let us know (see above) and bring in the proof  
when your child returns to school.
