The KS1 Class with the highest attendance was Class 5 with 99% and the KS2 Class with the highest attendance was Class 12 with 100%. 😊

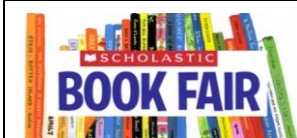
