Advance Notice – Archibald Open Afternoon

Our Annual Open Afternoon will take place from 2pm on Monday 17th July.

This is an opportunity for you to come into school to collect your child's annual report from their class teacher. Your child will then be able to take you to meet their new class teachers and see their new classroom.

Working parent? You could be entitled to 30 hours FREE childcare under new scheme.

From September, free childcare available to working parents will be set at 30 hours per week, double the amount currently available.

The extra allocation has been designed to make it easier for parents to work, while also providing access to childcare opportunities for disadvantaged children.

We have a limited number of 30 hour places available in our EYFS from September.

To be eligible for the free childcare increase, both parents must be working, or the sole parent if in a lone parent family.

Each parent must have a weekly minimum income equivalent to 16 hours at national minimum wage, and an income of less than £100,000 per year.

The entitlement will be available during term time, which equates to 38 weeks per year.
