A member of the school nursing team will be in school every Friday from 1:30pm. If you would like to meet a member of the team please let Miss Chapman know.

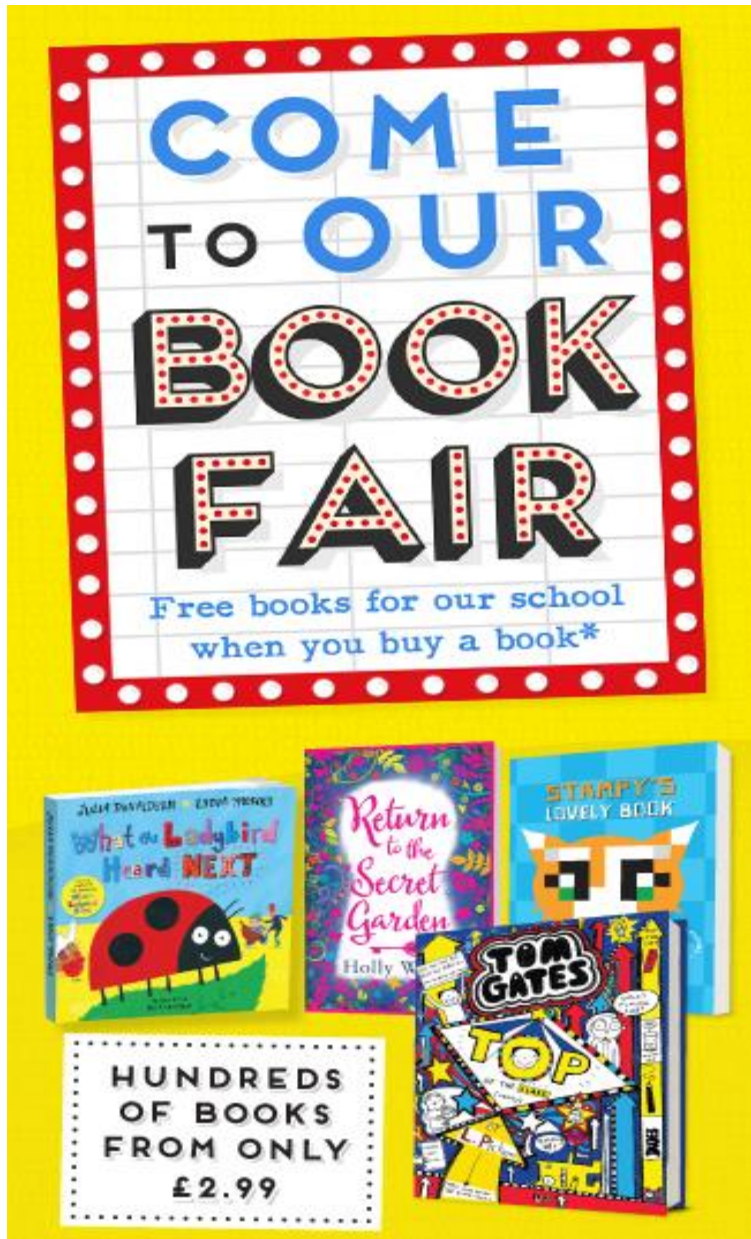
