Please be aware that:-

- Unfortunately pushchairs cannot be taken into the hall. This is because space is restricted.

- You are expected to stay for the duration of the show. You will not be allowed to leave early.
- Seats are provided. If you want to stand you must stand at the back of the hall so as not to stop others from seeing the show.
- Whilst we do not charge for tickets, there will be a voluntary collection at the end in aid of school funds.
