Nursery Refurbishment

At the end of this term our school nursery will be remodelled and refurbished. The plans are on display in the main entrance and include:-

- A new nursery entrance into the outside area. Pupils and parents/carers will be able to enter and leave nursery through this entrance.
 - New toilet exclusively for Nursery children. Currently Nursery and Reception share toilet facilities.
 - A brand new 'wet room' with disabled toilet facilities.
 - A new, larger, brighter group room.
 - Demolition of many internal walls creating a new, bright and exciting learning environment.
 - Improved storage for resources.
 - New ceilings and improved lighting, refurbished and improved flooring throughout the Nursery.
 - Improved display boards and ICT facilities
- Due to this extensive work there will be some short-term changes to Nursery provision in September. Parents and carers of pupils involved will be notified.

In addition there will be other work going on in the school during the Summer Holiday, including:-

- Redecoration and new furniture for our Y5 classrooms
- Redecoration of the KS1 corridor.
- Redecoration of the KS1 cloakroom areas.
- Modifications to the Reception classrooms.

Middlesbrough Armed Forces Day Saturday 20th June Parade starts at 11am

Centre Square will provide a fitting backdrop for this fun filled family day, including a parade, band performance and a variety of demonstrations, activities and entertainments

Highlight of the day will be a parade of service veterans, Air Sea and Army Cadets, the military standards, veterans, local army and sea cadet units.
