The KS2 classes with the highest attendance for the week were Classes 8, 13, 15 and 16, each with 100%.

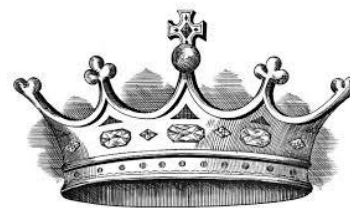
