### **TRANSITION DAY**

On Friday 1<sup>st</sup> July all pupils will spend the day working with their new class teachers in their new classrooms. At the end of the day parents/carers will need to collect your children from their new exit doors/classrooms at the end of the day as follows:-

**New Y1** – collect from Y1 classrooms

**New Y2** – KS2 playground - pupils will be released by teachers from the glass doors in the link corridor.

**New Y3** – KS1 playground – pupils will be released by their new teachers from the blue doors leading into the KS1 playground.

**New Y4** - Main Entrance – pupils will be released by their teachers from the main entrance.

**New Y5 & New Y6** – Pupils are dismissed by their teachers from the doors leading to the grass near to the climbing frame.

If you are unsure where to collect your child, please ask them to show you before the transition day, ask your child's current class teacher, or ask the school office.

Tea Time team will be open as normal. Please be aware that only pupils currently in Y4, Y5 or Y6 are allowed to walk home on their own providing that their parents/carers have completed the appropriate form available from the school office.
