## Did you know.....?

If you think you are being bullied, or are worried about someone else being bullied, you can now tell someone in total confidence online using Tootoot which is really easy to use!

Tootoot was re launched during our successful Anti-bullying week. Each child in KS2 should have received a leaflet on how to use Tootoot. On the front of their leaflet is their personal username and password to access the website.

Tootoot allows pupils to anonymously share their worries and concerns in confidence.

An adult will look into their worry and will reply to them.

When your child logs back in to Tootoot, click on ‘Open Cases’ where you will see the details of your worry and a reply to you will be posted.
