Announcing Early Years Education for Two Year Olds on Our School Site.

We are delighted to announce that we will be able to offer free part-time early education for up to 15 hours a week during term time from September 2016 for eligible children.

If you earn less than £16,190, or are on benefits, you may be able to get 15 hours free childcare for your two year old in our school from September 2016.

If you are on any of these benefits, your child should be eliqible for a place:-

- •Income support or Income-based Jobseeker's Allowance (JSA)
- •Income-related Employment and Support Allowance (ESA) •Child Tax Credit (but not Working Tax Credit) and have an annual income not over £16,190
- •Guaranteed element of State Pension Credit
- •Support under Part 6 of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999 •Working Tax Credit and earn £16,190 a year or less

Places in our brand new refurbished two year old provision from September are limited and early reservation is recommended. The provision will be staffed by a fully qualified teacher supported by appropriately qualified and experienced support staff. It will operate in close collaboration with our Nursery Class ensuring a smooth transition into Nursery when your child is eligible and a place is available.

To reserve a place for your child, or for further information please enquire at the school office.

Archibald Tea Time Team

This provision is proving extremely popular and is available each school day from 3pm – 5:45pm. Children are able to attend for up to 1 hour, up to 2 hours or for the whole session. We already have approximately 15 children attending each afternoon, and numbers are increasing quickly.
