ATTENDANCE NEWS

Pupils in Reception, Y1 and Y2 have free fruit snacks provided each day. This is funded through a government scheme. KS2 pupils are encouraged to bring their own fruit snack to enjoy at break time if they want to.

Water is available to all pupils at lunchtime. In addition, pupils who take school lunches are able to have milk to drink with their lunch.

- If you do not want to use the tickets issued to you, please return them to the school office.
- If you require any additional tickets, these will be available from the office on a first come, first served basis.
