Rights Respecting School Award



We are currently working towards achieving UNICEF Rights Respecting School Award (RRSA). The Rights Respecting Schools Award recognises achievement in putting the United Nations Convention on the Rights of the Child (UNCRC) at the heart of our school's planning, policies, practice and ethos.

As a rights-respecting school we not only teach our pupils about children's rights but also model rights and respect in all relationships within school - between teachers/adults and pupils, between adults and between pupils. You will start to see some of our displays and documents referenced to UNCRC, and Class Charters being displayed in classrooms.
