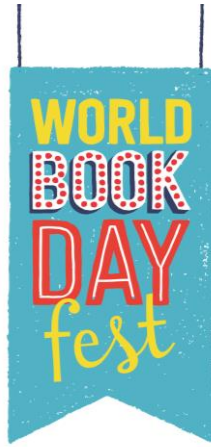


Thursday March 3rd - World Book Day
