Swimming

Y4 will be going swimming every afternoon this week. They will need their swimming kits in school each day.

Y3 classes will be going swimming at the Neptune Pool next term. This will be in the first two weeks of term (starting on Tuesday 5th January) and again for two weeks straight after the half term holiday (wb 22.2.16 and wb29.2.16).

Swimming is part of the KS2 National Curriculum for PE and all pupils are expected to participate in lessons. If your child can not swim they will gain confidence in water during the first few weeks and will quickly learn to swim. The government expectation is that all pupils can swim at least 25 metres by the time they leave primary school.
