

## Archibald Primary School Sports Premium 2015-2016

The Primary PE and Sports Premium was launched by the Government in April 2013 and is available for three academic years: 2013/2014, 2014/2015 and 2015/2016.

For this academic year (2015 – 2016) the school received **£9490** to help us to improve the quality and breadth of our PE and sport provision.
