World Book Day 2018

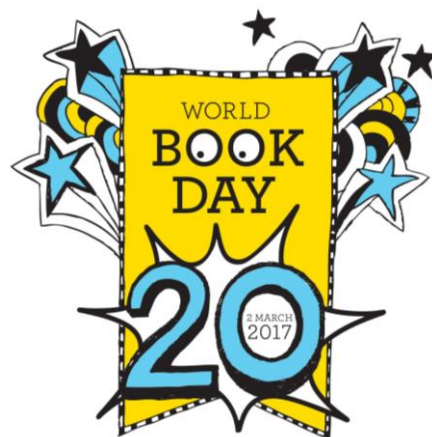
World Book Day 2017 will take place on Thursday 1st March. As in previous years, all pupils will be given a £1 book token. When you get your book token, all you need to do is to take it to a local bookseller (including Waterstones and WHSmith in the town centre) and swap it for one of the **TEN** (exclusive, new and **completely FREE**) World Book Day books. Alternatively, older pupils may wish to put it towards one of the **FIVE fantastic full-length books** for teens priced at only £2.50 each at participating stores (that's **ONLY £1.50** with your £1 book token).

Or, if you'd prefer, you can use your book token to get **£1 off** any full price book instead. If you'd rather get an audiobook, that's fine too! It's your choice, just as long as the book or audiobook costs at least £2. The World Book Day book tokens are valid from **Monday 26 February– Sunday 25 March 2018**.
