## Y3 Swimming

Y3 pupils will be attending swimming lessons at the Neptune Pool every afternoon this week and for the first week after the Easter Holiday (wb 16<sup>th</sup> April). **Pupils will need their swimming kit in school every day.** Swimming lessons are part of the National Curriculum. The government expectation is that all pupils can swim at least 25m by the time they leave primary school. At Archibald Primary swimming lessons are in Y3 and Y4.

## How to help your child stay safe online

Online gaming means you can play in real time with people across the world through a computer, games console, tablet or smartphone connected to the internet.

Games can offer children a world of adventure to immerse themselves in, but it's important to understand how children can stay safe and what games are appropriate for their age.
