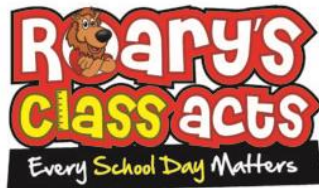

This course is delivered in a relaxed, friendly and informal setting. The aim is to build confidence, share experiences, encourage and empower parents to believe in themselves. We want to enable parents to make changes big or small to make a happy home for all concerned.

The objectives of the course are to:

Discuss why it is important to have rules in everyday life.

- Look at different ways we can build a better relationship with our children.
- Define what targets and boundaries mean and look at how setting them can help us.
- Explore suitable sanctions and rewards.
- Explore how change in our behaviour can enhance the behaviour in our children.
