SCHOOL MEALS UPDATE

Please be aware that the price of a school meal will increase to £2 per day from September 2018.

If you think that you may be able to apply for free school meals please contact the school office who will advise you on how to apply and support you in your application.

This could save you up to £380 per child each year!

Eligibility for Free School Meals

Your child might be able to get free school meals if you get any of the following:

- Income Support
- Income-based Jobseeker's Allowance
- Income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- Support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- The guaranteed element of Pension Credit
- Child Tax Credit (provided you're not also entitled to Working Tax Credit and have an annual gross income of no more than £16,190)
- Working Tax Credit run-on - paid for 4 weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit
- Universal Credit - if you apply on or after 1 April 2018 your household income must be less than £7,400 a year (after tax and not including any benefits you get)

All pupils in Reception, Y1 and Y2 are entitled to Free School Meals, but please do still apply if you think you meet the criteria above as our school receives extra funding based on the numbers of pupils we have registered for Free School Meals. We use this additional funding to enhance our provision in school, including to help support smaller class sizes, additional TA support and subsidies for school visits.

Summer Term Family Challenge

Last week we launched our Summer Term LORIC Family Challenge. The theme of our Summer Term Family Challenge this year is 'World Cup Warriors' and we are holding our challenge this year to tie in with the World Cup tournament which is taking place in Russia. All pupils have been issued with a Family Challenge grid containing the tasks that can be completed with their families. Breakfast Club

We run a very successful and popular breakfast club every morning. Breakfast Club opens at 8am, with breakfast being served until 8:30am. Pupils remain in Breakfast Club until 8:45am when they are able to enter their classrooms.

At Breakfast Club pupils are provided with breakfast which includes a choice of cereal, toast and juice or milk drinks. They then participate in a range of popular, supervised outdoor or indoor activities (construction, drawing and colouring, board games, snooker etc). Regular competitions are held and prizes awarded.

Please be aware that due to an increase in staffing and food costs the price of Breakfast Club will increase with effect from Monday 25th June. The revised charges are:-
Price per pupil (per day).....£1.60
Price per pupil (per week - pay in advance)..... £7.50
This is a saving of 50p per week on the daily charge.

School Uniform

Now is the time to start thinking about ordering school uniform in order to help guarantee delivery before the end of term. We will continue to take orders at the office right up to the end of term, however in order to help guarantee delivery before the summer holidays please place orders by Friday July 6th.

We now have an order form for all school uniform items. The order form is available from the school office, on our school website and is at the end of this newsletter.

The order form contains information on the sizes and prices of each item which are guaranteed until the end of term.

Please be aware that whilst we encourage pupils to wear our school logo on their uniform this is not compulsory and school uniform items without our logo are equally acceptable – providing that they are in the correct colours. These can be purchased at varying prices from many different stores.
