Welcome back to a new school year!

A special welcome to all the pupils and parents who are joining us for the first time this year, not only in Reception but in all year groups throughout the school. We have some new staff joining us too – Miss Laden will be teaching in Y3, Mrs Anderson will be teaching in our Nursery every Friday and Miss Petty will be leading our Pre – School provision.

This term will be as busy as ever, and the best way to keep up to date with what is happening is to keep checking the weekly newsletter, and ensuring that our school office has your most up to date contact details so that we can keep you up top date through our text messaging service.

Last year we had 29 pupils with 100% attendance – not missing one day of school from September 2017 to July 2018. This is a fantastic achievement and one we are hoping to beat this year – improving school attendance continues to be one of our main school improvement priorities this year. Remember all children should be in school on time every day unless they are too ill to attend, in which case you must contact the school office or attendance officer to let us know. Medical appointments should be made outside of school time and if this is unavoidable then you must bring proof of the appointment in to school for our records. Pupils are not permitted to go on holiday in school time, or stay off school on their birthday. Such absences are recorded as unauthorised and are monitored by our educational social worker.

Pupils who attend school on time everyday will continue to be rewarded by being included in our half termly Roary Club Prizes. On the final day of last term we held our final Roary Club and 190 pupils joined in Commando Joe activities on the MUGA with Mr Cutter and Mr Farrington.
