## End of Term Performances

All performances will take place in our dining hall, and as in previous years entry will be by ticket only. This is for health and safety reasons.

Tickets are free and will be sent home later this week.

Each pupil will be given two tickets. If you do not need all your tickets, please return them to the school office so that can be offered to someone else on a first come – first served basis.

Please be aware that for each performance:-

- There is no space in the hall for pushchairs. Babies can be carried and the pushchair left in the entrance area, however, if your baby starts to cry and disturb the performance you may be asked to take the baby out of the hall.
- If you require disabled or wheelchair access to any performance please let the school office know in advance so arrangements can be made to accommodate this in advance.
- The performance will start promptly and there will be no admission to the hall once the performance has started.
- If you need to leave the performance you will not be allowed to re-enter the hall
- There will be enough seats for all ticket holders. You are expected to remain seated throughout the performance. Standing room will be at the back of the hall only. Under no circumstances will you be allowed to stand at the sides of the hall. This is for safety reasons.
- Children in school will have opportunities to watch many of the performances, so where possible should not be brought to the after – school performances. If this is unavoidable they will be expected to remain seated throughout and not move around in the hall.
- There will be photograph opportunities at the end of each performance. Please do not take photographs of videos during the performances. This is for safeguarding reasons.

## CHRISTMAS APPEAL 2018

This year the staff at Archibald Primary School will be donating to local foodbanks in Middlesbrough.

We don't think anyone in our community should have to face going hungry. Foodbanks provide three days' nutritionally balanced emergency food and support to local people in crisis who are referred to them.

We will be setting up collection boxes in the main entrance until **Tuesday 18<sup>th</sup> December**.

We want to give what we can to make a difference this season. If you would like to contribute with our staff you can put your food items into the boxes in the main entrance.

There is a list of preferred foods below:-

Middlesbrough Foodbank URGENTLY need:-

- UHT powdered milk
- Long life fruit juice/cordial
- Sponge puddings
- Coffee
- Rice Pudding
- Packet mash/tinned potatoes
- Tinned carrots, sweetcorn, mixed vegetables
- Tinned fruit
- Tinned meat (ham, spam, hot dogs, pies, stews, curries)

Foodbank Shopping List:-

- Pasta (not spaghetti or lasagne sheets)
- Breakfast cereal
- Tinned rice pudding
- Jam, marmalade, peanut butter, chocolate spread
- Biscuits (prefer sweet biscuits)
- Snacks and treats (chocolate bars, crisps etc)
- Packet soups
- Custard tins or custard powder mix
